

# Empty V-EMB

## Labelling:

- The Pool Packaging you have on site has been registered on your individual Dealer packaging accounts. The return flow of empty packaging is registered by the Carrier hub. The return flow is followed up regularly.
- It is essential to ensure that ALL empty V-EMB flows coming from your account can be registered by the carrier hub in order to remove the packaging from your account.
- In order to enable correct registration of the returns it is very important that each bundle is labelled with dealer Id and company details to identify the returning dealer. If there are no labels the receiving hub are not able register the return.
- Labels should be securely attached, using staples for wooden packaging or tape. Be sure to place in such a position that it is clearly visible.
- A single label should be sufficient for each bundle.

We can see some examples of how returns should be labeled:

This is important to avoid labeling and information being lost during transport.

Packaging must be securely strapped to using plastic strapping the use of **metal strapping is not acceptable.**
